

Year-to-Year Change in Nonfarm Jobs MARCH 2016*



How's the economy?

Tooele County year-over employment growth measured at 5.1 percent in March 2016, for a total 748 net new jobs . This growth was driven primarily by gains in transportation & warehousing (420), education/healthcare (146) and professional/business services (143). Average monthly wages declined 1.4 percent in the first quarter relative to the prior year.

Jobs

In March 2016, year-over jobs increased by 5.1 percent, an addition of 748 net new payroll jobs.



The largest increases occurred in trade/transportation/utilities employment -- impacted primarily by gains in transportation/warehousing which added 272 jobs.



Year-over nonfarm job changes have remained positive for a year, with the last job losses having occurred in March 2015.




Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate JUNE 2016





Initial Claims for Unemployment Insurance

Unemployment and Wages

The Tooele County unemployment rate measured at 4.3 percent in June.



An estimated 1,287 workers were unemployed in June compared to 1,216 a year earlier.



In June, there were an estimated 28,539 employed Tooele County residents either working within the county or commuting to work outside the area.



Average monthly wages fell 1.4 percent in the first quarter of 2016 relative to the prior year.



Dwelling Unit Permits





Year-to-Year Change In Gross Taxable Sales FIRST QUARTER 2016





Construction and Sales

Tooele County had 50 new dwelling unit permits from January to March 2016, a 59 percent decrease relative to last year.

Construction averaged 754 jobs in the first quarter of 2016, nearly equaling the 2015 employment level of 753.

The total permitted value of construction from January to March 2016 was \$9.1 million, a 65 percent reduction relative to 2015.

Taxable sales in Tooele County totaled \$161.8 million in first quarter 2016, 2.4 percent above the prior year.
